

Recently I submitted an article titled, "In the BEGINNING..." To take that a step further, the focus of this article is on God specifically.

While there are many, many important Bible verses about God, Genesis 1:1 (a verse upon which the entire rest of the Bible is founded) refutes "atheism" (the theory or belief that God does not exist). "The fool has said in his heart, 'There is no God" (Psalm 14:1).

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse" (Romans 1:18-20).
