



Raymond "Joe" Powell

Raymond "Joe" Powell, age 86, of Mount Gilead, died peacefully on Saturday, January 6, 2024, at Woodside Village Nursing Home following an extended ill-

On January 1, 1938, Joe was born in Campbellsville, Kentucky, one of nine children of the late John W. and Esther

(Ford) Powell. He attended Campbellsville school and served for 9 years in the US Army Reserves from 1955-1964.

Finding his life partner at an early age, Joe married Barbara Sue Shirrell, on December 8, 1956, eloping in Indiana. Together they raised five children: Tammy, Kurt, Greg, Jeff, and Robin. He was her caregiver for ten plus years, and was by her side until the end. She preceded him in death on March 23,

In the early 1960's, Joe moved to Morrow County, Ohio, for work during the oil boom. While working in the oil field in 1966, he injured his arm in an accident. He never let injuring an arm slow him down. Once he healed from the accident, he earned his welding certificate from the Galion Welding School in 1967. He worked as a welder for the Marion Power Shovel for ten years, and then for the Flexible Corporation in Delaware for a short time. He then taught welding at the Delaware JVS. Lastly, he was a welding supervisor for General Dynamics in Lima, overseeing welding on their Army tank cars, until his retirement in 1989.

After retiring, Joe and Barb lived out of their camper, spending their summers at the Dogwood Valley in Mount Gilead, and their winters at a campsite in Biloxi, Mississippi. They enjoyed working to get their campsites for free with Joe working security, and Barb cleaning the shelter houses and rentals. In his younger years, Joe also enjoyed going fishing.

One of Joe's favorite pastimes was going to see the "doctor", which was his code for hitting the casinos. He loved visiting "Dr. Eldorado" Scioto Downs, "Dr. Belterra", to name a few. He also enjoyed finding a good place to play BINGO with his family and friends.

Very hardworking, Joe worked two or three jobs for most of his life to help make a better life for his family. He was easy going and quiet, and if he had something to share it was often incredibly thoughtful. He also had an ornery streak that often came out when he was surrounded by his family

Left to cherish his memory are his four children: Tammy (Al) Weller of Mount Gilead, Kurt (Peggy) Powell of Cardington, Jeff (Kathy) Powell of Mount Gilead, and Robin (Gene) Ebert of Cardington; 19 grandchildren; 31 great-grandchildren; one great-great grandchild on the way; numerous nieces and nephews; and his furry friend, Petey.

Including Barb and his parents, Joe was preceded in death by his son, Greg Powell; and all 8 of his siblings: Guy Bright, John William Powell, Tommy McLelland, Mary E. Graham, Maude Kelly, Marie Pierce, and infant twins: Bobby and Jaycee Powell.
