To the Mt. Gilead School District Taxpayers,

By now you have received your Property Tax Statements. Once again, you will see they went up quite substantially and once again, the Mt. Gilead school district gets more of your hard-earned money. Depending on the amount of your Property Tax, they get 50% to 69% or more depending on your property. With the raise they got from your Property Tax, why do they need another .75% 5-year levy?

The school system has had a continuous Levy of .75% since January 1, 2010 on Earned income.

On May 7, 2019, they paced another .75% additional (Not a renewal) on the ballot in a Special Election which passed. This was a 5 year Levy. Now the taxpayers are paying 1.50% off of their Earned Income. Now, what is special about this Levy is it was a special election in an off year. This Levy was not listed as an additional Tax. Now they are placing it on the ballot 2 years early. You can check with the Board of Elections and they will give you the same information.

I questioned the Board of Elections as to why it was not listed as an additional tax. They advised me that the Secretary of State's office controls the wording of the Ballot. I contacted the Secretary of State's office and still have not received an answer.

If you look at some of the surrounding school districts, they operate off of .50% to 1% Earned Income:

Cardington School District	.75%	(Cardington does Not tax Social Security or Retirement Funds)
Highland	.50%	
Northmor	1%	
Marion County	1% or less	

All of these figures are public record.

Mt. Gilead School could do the same thing as Cardington School district to take the pressure off of our senior citizens.

Here are actual figures the Mt. Gilead School District collects:

Local	\$7,348,905.00
State	\$7,567,337.00
Federal	\$1,737,499.00
Other	<u>\$1,184,744.00</u>
Total	\$17,838,485.00

Some of the monies listed under Other are from the Thomas B Fordham Institute. All figures are public record.

Did you know that parents pay Student supply fees of \$35.00 per student? The School Board also provides a list of supplies for the parents to buy. This includes Pencils, Highlighters, Folders, Notebooks, Paper, and the list goes on.

There are 1,039 students in the Mt. Gilead High School. \$35.00 x 1,039 equals out to \$36,365.00. This does not include a \$10.00 Class fee for Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors. There is also additional \$20.00 Technology Fee for Freshmen and Sophomores. With the cost of Inflation, everyone is just making ends meet. Gas, Groceries, and Utilities are way up. Families are having a hard time making ends meet. What about our Senior citizens? I know several seniors that need to make monthly payments on their Property Tax. They cannot afford 6 months or an Annual payment, The County Auditor and Treasurer should be commended for being flexible and working with these folks.

The school needs to learn to live off a budget like everyone else.

In 2001, myself and several concerned Taxpayers collected signatures for the repeal of the continuous .75% Levy. We were told a 5-year Levy of .75% could not be repealed.

The signatures were collected and submitted to the board of elections. The Board of Elections certified the signatures and the repeal was going to be placed on the ballot. The School Board hired the Law firm of Bricker and Eckel of Columbus to file a protest against our petition. A hearing was conducted at the Board of Elections on April 5, 2022. They challenged some of the signatures. Some of the things challenged were the way they signed their name, a County Road turning into a Township road the way CR or TR was listed, just nick-picky stuff. They challenged almost every signature. We won most of the challenges, but in the end, we were short by 9 signatures. Those mistakes will not happen again.

The attorney's fees to represent the school board cost \$7,199.50. More taxpayer money. What I don't understand is why they had to hire a Law Firm? Was there no one on the School Board that could represent the school? There is an attorney on the School Board. Why couldn't they let the taxpayers decide?

If you're interested in what some of our Superintendents/or Principles make, it may surprise you. It is public record. Google it. The Superintendent is 6 figures.

Well now you know the rest of the story as Paul Harvey would say.

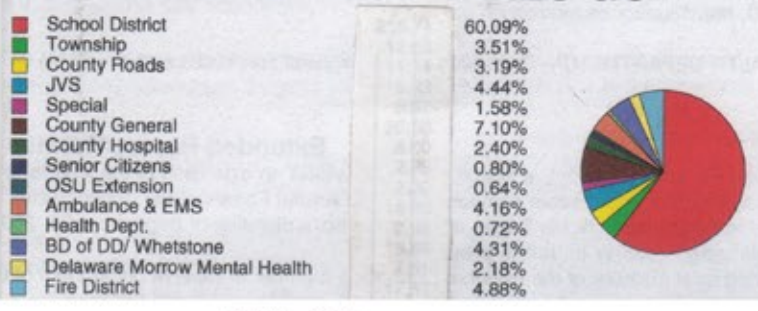

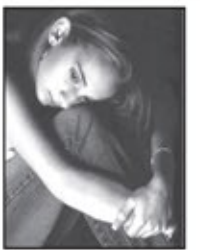

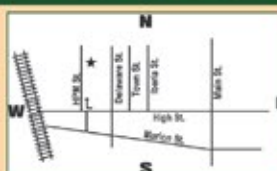
