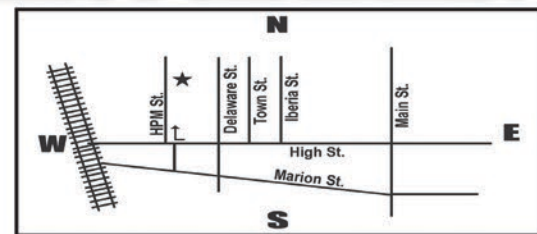

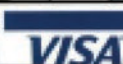

Harry was a man of few words. He absolutely loved his family and was always there for you.


