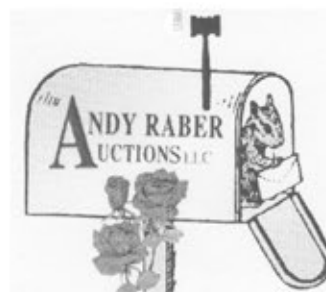

Pass the Salt

"And every offering of your grain offering you shall season with salt; you shall not allow the salt of the covenant of your God to be lacking from your grain offering. With all your offerings you shall offer salt" (Lev. 2:13).

Under the law of Moses, all offerings had to be salted.

- Salt was eaten with food; in fact, some foods could not be eaten without it (Job 6:6).
- Elisha used it to heal a spring of bad water (2 Kings 2:19-22).
- Both God's covenant to give Israel's heave offerings to the priests forever, and his covenant to give the kingdom of Israel to the house of David forever, are described in the Scriptures as "a covenant of salt" (an expression used to demonstrate the enduring nature of a covenant, Num. 18:19; 2 Chron. 13:5).

The Scriptures do not seem to reveal why salt was used in covenants; however, the Israelites did not need to know WHY the salt was important. All they needed to know was simply the fact that it WAS important (so important that no offerings could be presented without it). Therefore, they could not allow the salt of the covenant to be lacking from any meat offering that they brought to the Lord.

Jesus said, "salt is good," as long as it retains its "saltiness" (Mark 9:50). In the Matthew 5:13 He put it this way, "You are the salt of the earth, but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men." In that broader passage Jesus uses two figures (light and salt) that illustrate the role God would have the Christian to play in His kingdom (Matt. 5:13-16).

- Like light and salt, his people are to guide, enlighten, preserve, and season the world around them.
- Both figures inherently demonstrate a contrast which must exist between the world and the child of God.
- Without the salt that God would have his people disperse, the world around them, like unsalted (uncured) food, will spoil.
- Salt's influence is described as "aseptic; i.e., preventing the spread of corruption." (Think of it, for the lack of ten righteous souls Sodom perished, Gen. 18:16-33).
- Without light, darkness will prevail.

Both figures also infer the evangelistic nature of the gospel. It is not enough for children of God to possess salt and light within themselves. They are expected "shake and shine!"

In ancient times salt was considered a valuable commodity. (Our English word "salary" is derived from the Latin sal meaning "salt"). According to one source, pure salt cannot "lose its flavor." Evidently there were various types of impure salts common to Israel that were known to lose their sodium chloride, leaving crystals with insufficient salt content. Eugene Deatrick (in his book, "Salt, Soil, Savior") writes, "Jesus surely did not allude to pure sodium chloride, which is a chemically stable compound, but rather to one of the complex salts of Palestine, which can lose savor through physical disintegration or through mixture with gypsum."

Here are two ways the Scriptures exhort saltiness (pure and without disintegration) in children of God:

- (1) "Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one." (Col. 4:6). When it comes to sharing God's word with others (v. 5), PASS THE SALT!
- (2) "Have salt in yourselves" (Mark 9:49-50). The Christian exists to the world as its preservative agent. To fail to serve this function is to reject the purpose and nature of a citizen of the kingdom. So, PASS THE SALT!

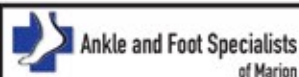

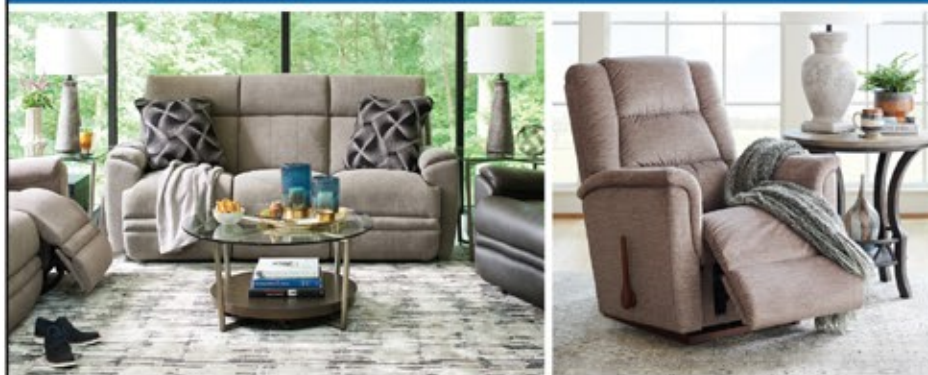
