HOT WEATHER, DEADLY FOR DOGS

Hot weather, inside or out, in the house or in the car - can be deadly for dogs. All dog, whether Mexican Chihuahuas or Eskimo Malamutes, are heat intolerant. Every year dogs will die from the heat - in Brownsville, Texas and in Bangor, Maine. Well, maybe not in Bangor. I'm certain your dog's veterinarian can relate horror stories of heat induced death of dogs they see every year. And this is a terrible way to die.

All dogs developed from Northern European or Northern Asian Wolves. Yes, even Chihuahuas. Pogs can't tolerate excessive heat and humidity, especially when confined in a car, on a chain or in a hot room. When I was in veterinary practice i was called to see a young Husky that had been confined under a shade tree. The owners had tried to do everything right: shade, water and food. However in their absence, the sun and shade had moved and the water dish knocked over. The dog was dead.

You farm animal and livestock owners, this applies to their situation too - Shade, water, air.

Heat stroke is difficult to treat, often expensive and usually unsuccessful. So, during these hot summer months confine your dog or dogs (as well as all animals) in shady areas where the air can move and there is plenty of water to drink. Do not leave dogs OR CHILDREN confined in a car. That will kill them! And don't forget your dog's heartworm preventive.
