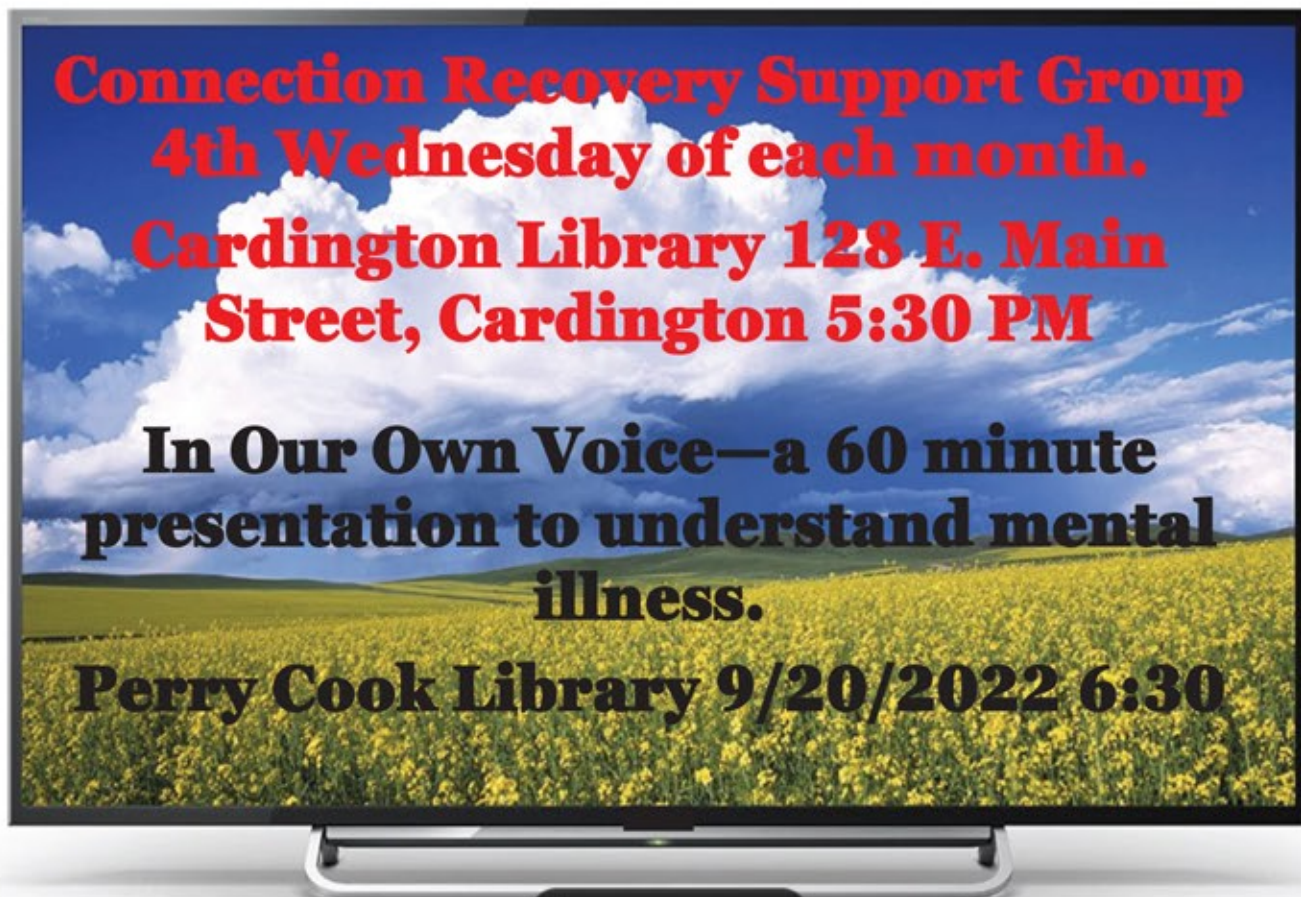



If you were ever looking for a statement upon which you can build the rest of your life; if you really want something that is trustworthy and full of confidence and hope, then you need to look no further than 1 Timothy 1:15: "This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief."

In this verse the apostle Paul makes a profound claim: **Christ came to save sinners.** We are assured that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23); and as a result, death has spread to all men "because all sinned" (5:12). "Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon" (Isaiah 55:7).
