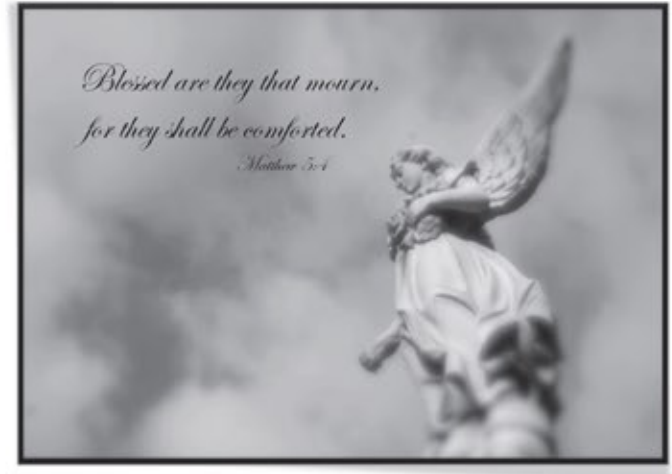

Dorothy M. "Dot" (Cronenwett) Rensch, age 99, of Mount Gilead, passed away on Saturday, August 12, 2023, at her home surrounded by her loved ones.

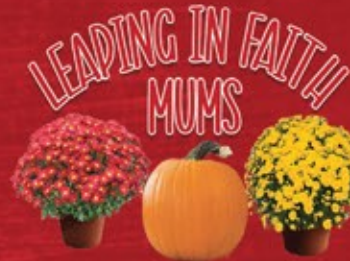
