"Lord, I Have Sinned, But I Have Several Excellent Excuses"

I don't know how much you read, but you'll probably find that books are somewhat like sermons (some are easy to read, while others are long and tedious). A good example of the latter is Leo Tolstoy's book, "War and Peace." massive volume, there is a major character named Pierre. At one point Pierre was forced to confront himself and his actions, and to do some serious self-examination. So he prayed to God and said, "Yes Lord, I have sinned, but I have several excellent excuses."

Well, most of us can really relate to Pierre on this; we all sin. but we have several excellent excuses. It's so easy to excuse our behavior ("God made us this way," or "It's the society in which we live," or "It's the dysfunctional family in which we were brought up," etc.). Adam got it all started way back there in the Garden of Eden because when he was confronted, he simply replied, "The woman You put here with me, she gave me some fruit from the tree and I ate it" (Gen. Adam excused his actions by not just blaming the woman, but in reality, by blaming God. "The woman YOU put here with me..." It sort of sounds like, "Lord, if YOU hadn't given me this woman (or this kind of woman) none of this ever would have happened."

The expression, "I have sinned," is found 19 times in the Bible. Pharaoh (who had enslaved the descendants of Jacob) said it twice during the difficult days of the plagues that befell his nation (Exod. 9:27; 10:16). Saul, the first king of Israel, said it three times (1 Sam. 15:24, 30; 26:21). His successor, King David (of whom God said, "He is a man after My own heart") said it five times - more than anyone else in the Bible (2 Sam. 12:13; 19:20; 24:10, 17; 1 Chron. 21:8)! You might be thinking, "How could a man that goes around sinning all the time be a man after God's own heart?" Well David possessed a humble and repentant heart. He said in Psalm 51:3, "I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me." He didn't deny his sin. Unlike Saul, he didn't offer several excellent excuses. He didn't blame it on someone else or try to justify it. He simply admitted it, agonized over it, repented of it, and sought God's forgiveness.

One danger of making an alibi for sin is that it keeps us from seeing ourselves the way we really are. If we are convinced that we're doing nothing wrong (when in reality we are), we'll never take that "wrong-doing" before God, repent of it, and ask His forgiveness. The truth is excuse-making blinds us to reality. While we are casually finding ways to excuse our sins, we forget that God sees and knows everything (Heb. 4:13).

In Luke 14:16-24 Jesus tells of a man who invited many people to a great banquet. They all accepted the invitation, but when the day arrived and they were reminded of their commitment, they all, with one accord, began to make excuses. "I bought a piece of land..." "I've bought five yoke of oxen..." "I've married a wife..." The Lord is simply showing us how foolish and nonsensical our feeble excuses are to Him. God is not interested in hearing our excuses but in forgiving our sins. Yet when we make excuses for our sins and won't face up to our actions, He cannot forgive. Friends, always remember this; we don't need a scapegoat, we need a Savior!

On December 22, 1962, Don married Marilynn J. Yake, she survives in Marion.


