The **PACT Act** is a new law that expands VA health care and benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits and other toxic substances. This law helps us provide generations of Veterans—and their survivors—with the care and benefits they've earned and deserve. The Act (1) expands and extends eligibility for VA health care for Veterans with toxic exposures and Veterans of the Vietnam era, Gulf War era, and Post 9/11 era, and (2) expands eligibility for benefits for Veterans exposed to toxic substances.

#### Vietnam era Veteran eligibility

**What new Agent Orange presumptive conditions will VA add?**

Based on the PACT Act, we've added 2 new Agent Orange presumptive conditions:

- High blood pressure (also called hypertension)
  - Monoclonal Gammopathy of undetermined significance (Blood Disorder that affects Plasma Cells)
- If you think you're eligible for VA health care and benefits, we encourage you to apply now.

**What new Agent Orange presumptive locations will VA add?**

- We've added these 5 new locations to the list of presumptive locations:
- Any U.S. or Royal Thai military base in Thailand from January 9, 1962, through June 30, 1976
  - Laos from December 1, 1965, through September 30, 1969
  - Cambodia at Mimot or Krek, Kampong Cham Province from April 16, 1969, through April 30, 1969
  - Guam or American Samoa or in the territorial waters off of Guam or American Samoa from January 9, 1962, through July 30, 1980
  - Johnston Atoll or on a ship that called at Johnston Atoll from January 1, 1972, through September 30, 1977
- If you served on active duty in any of these locations, we'll automatically assume (or "presume") that you had exposure to Agent Orange.

**What new radiation presumptive locations will VA add?**

- We've added these 3 new response efforts to the list of presumptive locations:
- Cleanup of **Enewetak Atoll**, from January 1, 1977, through December 31, 1980
  - Cleanup of the Air Force B-52 bomber carrying nuclear weapons off the coast of **Palomares, Spain**, from January 17, 1966, through March 31, 1967
  - Response to the fire onboard an Air Force B-52 bomber carrying nuclear weapons near **Thule Air Force Base in Greenland** from January 21, 1968, to September 25, 1968

#### Gulf War era and post-9/11 Veteran eligibility

**What burn pit and other toxic exposure conditions are now presumptive?**

We've added more than 20 burn pit and other toxic exposure presumptive conditions based on the PACT Act. This change expands benefits for Gulf War era and post-9/11 Veterans.

#### These cancers are now presumptive:

- Brain cancer
- Glioblastoma
- Kidney cancer
- Lymphoma of any type
- Melanoma
- Pancreatic cancer
- Respiratory (breathing-related) cancer of any type
- Gastrointestinal cancer of any type
- Head cancer of any type
- Lymphatic cancer of any type
- Neck cancer
- Reproductive cancer of any type

#### These illnesses are now presumptive:

- Asthma that was diagnosed after service
- Chronic bronchitis
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Chronic rhinitis
- Constrictive bronchiolitis or obliterative bronchiolitis
- Emphysema
- Granulomatous disease (Condition which causes the immune system to malfunction effecting white blood cells)
- Interstitial lung disease (ILD)
- Pleuritis (Inflammation of the membrane that surrounds the lungs)
- Pulmonary fibrosis
- Sarcoidosis (tiny collection of Inflammatory cells in different parts of the body)

**How do I know if I have a presumptive exposure to burn pits?**

If you served in any of these locations and time periods, we've determined that you had exposure to burn pits or other toxins. We call this having a presumption of exposure.

**On or after September 11, 2001, in any of these locations:**

- Afghanistan
- Jordan
- Uzbekistan
- Djibouti
- Lebanon
- Yemen
- Egypt
- Syria

**The airspace above any of these locations**  
**On or after August 2, 1990, in any of these locations:**

- Bahrain
- Oman
- Somalia
- Iraq
- Qatar
- The United Arab Emirates (UAE)
- Kuwait
- Saudi Arabia
- The airspace above any of these locations

### DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR VETERANS WHO WERE STATIONED AT CAMP LEJEUNE

VA has established a rule stating that those who were stationed at Camp Lejeune, MCAS New River, including all satellite camps and housing areas, from August 1, 1953 through December 31, 1987 who later developed one of the following 8 diseases can now receive disability benefits:

- \*Adult leukemia
- \*Aplastic anemia & other myelodysplastic syndromes
- \*Bladder cancer
- \*Kidney cancer
- \*Multiple myeloma
- \*Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma
- \*Parkinson's disease

Presently, these conditions are the only ones for which there is sufficient scientific and medical evidence to support the creation of presumptions; however, VA will continue to review relevant information as it becomes available.

### HEALTH BENEFITS

In accordance with the 2012 Camp Lejeune health care law, the VA also provides free health care for certain conditions to Veterans who served at least 30 days of active duty at Camp Lejeune from January 1, 1957 to December 31, 1987.

Qualifying health conditions for free health care include:

- \*Esophageal cancer
- \*Breast cancer
- \*Kidney cancer
- \*Multiple myeloma
- \*Renal toxicity
- \*Female infertility
- \*Scleroderma
- \*Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma
- \*Lung cancer
- \*Bladder cancer
- \*Leukemia
- \*Myelodysplastic syndromes
- \*Hepatic steatosis
- \*Miscarriage
- \*Neurobehavioral effects

### Transportation

**We transport veterans to VA Healthcare appointments.**

1. Van transport is scheduled Monday through Thursday for morning appointments
2. Veterans should call to reserve a seat at least 48 hours before scheduled transport
3. Spouse/Caregiver may accompany Veteran if space is available and Veteran requests in advance
4. Drivers reserve the right to refuse transport to any passenger if there is reasonable belief that the passenger is too ill to travel or may be at risk to self or others

### Honor Flights to Washington D.C. Memorial Free Flights for Veterans

The Honor Flight Network recognizes American veterans for their sacrifices and achievements by flying them to Washington, D.C. to visit and reflect at the memorials built in their honor at no cost. Top priority is given to terminally ill veterans from all wars. Honor Flight is currently providing flights to all World War II and Korean Veterans. If you know of a veteran with a terminal illness, or a World War II or Korean Veteran, download a veteran application and then stop by our office for assistance completing the application and/or to turn in the application.



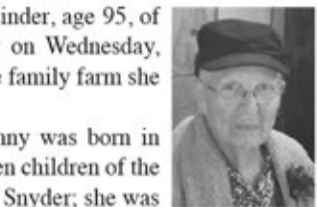

## Is The Sabbath Day The Lord's Day?

The Sabbath was a "holy day" of rest and worship for God's chosen people Israel under the Law of Moses. When God concluded the creation week, He rested on the seventh day (Saturday) - blessing it and sanctifying it (Gen. 2:2-3). While this is significant, it is also interesting that God was silent about this until the giving of the law approximately 2,600 years later. In fact, the first time the Sabbath is mentioned by name is in Exodus 16:23 after Israel was delivered from Egyptian bondage. Soon after, with the giving of the Ten Commandments, God said, "Remember the Sabbath, to keep it holy" (20:8).

It is important to note, that this law was not given to all peoples, only to Israel. The Sabbath was to remind Israel of their deliverance from Egyptian bondage (Deut. 5:15); and it was a sign between Israel and God, for He had sanctified them (Exod. 31:12-17). For as long as fleshly Israel would exist as a covenant people under the Law of Moses, they were to observe the Sabbath. However, God did not intend for that old covenant to last forever (Matt. 5:17-18), for he ushered in a new and better covenant (Heb. 8) designed for all people (Jew and Gentile) in Christ Jesus (Eph. 2:11-18).

Interestingly, in the church age (Acts 2 and beyond) the Sabbath is never commanded in Scripture. It was not enforced by the apostles, nor is there any biblical evidence that the early church ever worshipped on the Sabbath (their day of worship was Sunday, Acts 2; 20:7; 1 Cor. 16:1-2; cf. Rev. 1:10). Nor was there any penalty for not keeping the Sabbath (as there was under the Law of Moses). In fact, Paul assures us that Sabbath keeping was among the "handwriting of requirements" that was nailed to the cross (Col. 2:14-17).

Therefore, friends, to worship God acceptably we must do so according to the new covenant, not the old (Jn. 1:17; Gal. 2:16, 21; 3:10-25; 5:1-4; cf. Rom. 2:28-29), otherwise Christ will profit us nothing.
